1. When did you receive Christ as Lord and Savior in your life? Who or what influenced you to believe?
2. Worship. Belong. Serve. Go. These are the four words of Westwood's Discipleship Pathway. What is the big idea applied to each word?
3. When you hear the word "*evangelism*" what comes to mind?
4. In Matthew 28:18-19 *Jesus...said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations..."*
What does it mean for you to "Go"?
5. Pastor Joel invited us to embrace the three "P's of going: Go and be PRESENT. Go and PROCLAIM. Go knowing the Holy Spirit PERSUADES people to life in Christ. Explain the focus of each 'P' and it's result.
6. What does the acronym B.L.E.S.S. stand for? Are you a blesser or a converter? How did Pastor Joel distinguish between them? Does your understanding of "blesser" create for you the mindset, "I can do that!" Why?
7. What holds you or others back from sharing the love of Jesus Christ with others?
8. Do you have people in your sphere of influence who are far from God? If not, how might you fulfil this mission that God has for you? If so, what are you doing to help them come back to God? If you don't know what to do, say so, and talk together about what would help to build the bridge.
9. Are you willing to embrace this dream of God to use you to reach people in your context with the love of Jesus Christ? What do you think would be the impact on your life personally and the life and ministry of Westwood if you 'go' and are present and proclaim Jesus as Lord?
10. Close by sharing the first name of someone far from God and pray for your 'going' to them with the gospel and then 'receiving' Jesus as Lord.
