Kaboom: Stars, Dust and Sand #4

10 Here: Disciples Making Disciples

1. Read **Acts 1:8** together. Joel mentioned that we are receiving God's power, that we will be His witnesses to accomplish God's vision of his goodness and salvation to people here, near and far and that goodness is spread by kindness. Where have you seen God's goodness and kindness through His people recently?
2. Joel said: "If your dream doesn't scare you—it's not big enough". Sometimes our dreams are small, but God sized dreams can be big. What are your dreams? When you think of the $10 \times 10^2 \times 10^3$ vision, what thoughts, feelings or emotions arise?
3. Read **Proverbs 16:3**. Our plans must be in the will of God, for the glory of God. How do your future plans align with God, how do they differ?
4. Braydon and Jenna Andrews are small group leaders at our Minnetonka campus. They have been blessed and supported by their small group. Share with your group how you have been blessed and supported by being in a group with them.
5. As we think about launching 10 church plants, multi-site campuses or microsites, it's important to remember the uniqueness of each. For review, how did Joel distinguish between a church plant, multi-site and micro-site? (*For help, check the footnote.*¹) How can you personally and as a small group help in the launch of the new multi-site campus in the Fall of 2018?
6. One of the phrases introduced in the message and interview was "who's your next?" At the core of this statement is development—development of people and development of leaders.
 - a. How have you personally been developed as a leader or with specific skills?
 - b. When you think about your life who has been a great coach or mentor?
 - c. What person comes to mind who you can develop and pour into, who can be your next?
7. Read **Hebrews 4:16**. What words emerge? The author of Hebrews speaks of confidence. Do you feel you have confidence to approach the throne of grace? Why or why not?

¹ A **church plant** is Westbrook Community Church. Westwood sent Kevin Sharpe to Chaska with over 100 people, \$150,000 to plant a church – it has a separate life of its own.

A **multi-site campus** is one church that meets at multiple locations. They share the same mission, vision, and values, shared leadership and ministries; with common governance and one shared budget. Our first multi-site campus is Minnetonka, they share the same DNA, with teaching streamed from the Chanhassen campus.

A **micro-site** is a smaller group of believers who meet in homes or community sites. A house church; a video-venue in a restaurant. Our friend Matt who is in Moose Lake prison leads a group. He is a spiritual leader, he pastors them.
