1. Most of us experience times when we feel inadequate, but the areas of our “feelings of insufficiency” are varied. Which of the following areas do you tend to feel a sense of inadequacy?

2. Have you ever thought that if you could change something about yourself, you’d feel adequate for the situations you face? What is it that you would change?
3. Pastor Joel identified five reasons why we might ‘feel’ inadequate. Moses covers all five. Someone read the story of Moses and the Burning Bush from Exodus 3-4:17. We see a good summary of each reason in Moses encounter with God’s request. What is God’s request?
4. God’s response to Moses’ feelings is bold. Review the message outline. Choose one reason that aligns best with the area of inadequacy with which you struggle most. Review Moses’ feeling of inadequacy and God’s response. How do you identify with his feeling and how to do receive God’s response?
