2) Have you ever thought about the impact behind saying yes or someone saying yes to you? Have there been times in your life you wished you would have said yes but didn't? If so share about that experience.

3) Jill shared three promises or yeses that God says to us:

Yes I love you

Yes I made you

Yes I'm with you

4) Which one during this season of life do you most need to hear, believe and why?

5) Jill shared the line, "Behind every good yes there is often a hard no." What hard no's have you had to say over these years and is there one you need to say now so you can say yes? What is it?

6) Jill shared three yeses you could pick from to say to God as you step into this new year:

Yes I will follow

Yes I will serve

Yes I will share you

7) Which yes did you write down that you need to stay as you step into the new year and why? Does it seem scary or exciting or maybe both?

At the end of group pray for each person and for them and the yes they are going to say as they start the new year.
